

1. Introduction

This manual is intended for users of the Ami Mouse Cordless. No specific prior knowledge is needed to install and use this product.

If you have any questions after reading this manual, please contact one of the Trust service centres. You will find information on the service centre nearest to you at the back of this manual. You can also visit the Trust website (www.trust.com) for support, comprehensive product information, drivers, and FAQ's (Frequently Asked Questions).

1.1 Conventions used in this manual

The following conventions have been used in this manual to indicate instructions:

<key>	Here you should press a key. The name of the key is given between brackets.
'System'	This is a specific term used in a program. These are the terms used by, for example, Microsoft Windows 95.
[DIR]	Key in the text shown in square brackets [...].
(term)	The text between the parentheses (...) is the English term, e.g. (File) used in the figure referred to.

Additional information will be shown as follows:

Note: *The Ami Mouse Cordless only works on your computer's PS/2 port.*

The examples assume that the letter "D" has been assigned to your CD-ROM drive. If your system uses a different drive letter for your CD-ROM drive, for example "E", you should replace "D" by "E".

1.2 Contents of the package

Before reading the instruction manual, please check the contents of the package. It should contain the following:

- Ami Mouse Cordless
- Receiver with PS/2 connection
- CD-ROM containing the drivers and instruction manuals
- 2 x 1.5V batteries, type AAA
- Quick installation manual

Please contact your dealer if anything is missing or damaged.

1.3 Minimum system requirements

- 486-DX CPU
- Windows 95 / 98 / 2000 / NT4.0
- 16 MB RAM
- 10 MB free hard disk space
- 4 Speed CD-ROM
- Free PS/2 mouse port

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2. Before use

The drivers for your previous mouse must be removed before installing the software for the Ami Mouse Cordless. Consult the instruction manual for your previous mouse.

2.1 Connecting the receiver

1. Turn off the computer.
2. Remove the old mouse.
3. Remove the receiver from the packaging.
4. Connect the round PS/2 plug to the PS/2 mouse connection on your computer.

2.2 Positioning the receiver

For the best reception of signals from the mouse, it is recommended that you attach the receiver to the bottom or side of your monitor using the Velcro supplied.

Note: *Your mouse will not work if the infrared beam from the mouse to the receiver is interrupted.*

The mouse has two senders for an optimal working range of 160°. The green LED in the receiver indicates that there is a good transfer of data.

2.3 Fitting the batteries

1. Remove the mouse from the packaging.




Figure 1: The battery compartment

2. Turn the mouse upside down. The flap for the battery compartment will be visible (see figure 1).

3. Open the flap of the battery compartment.
4. Fit the batteries supplied.

Note: *Fit the batteries with the correct polarity as shown in the battery compartment.*

5. Replace the flap of the battery compartment until a soft click is heard.

3. Use of the mouse




Figure 2: Position of the buttons

A	Scroll wheel	Horizontal scrolling
B	Right mouse button	
C	Scroll wheel + third mouse button	Vertical scrolling Press the wheel to use the third mouse button.
D	Infrared window	
E	Left mouse button

4. Installation

Close all programs before installing the driver.

4.1 Trust Installer

Follow the points given below to start the Trust Installer:

1. Turn on the computer and start Windows.
If you are using Windows NT or Windows 2000, log in as 'Administrator'.
2. Insert the CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive.
3. Select 'Run' from the Start menu.
4. In the command line, type: [D:\SETUP.EXE] and click on 'OK' using the mouse.




Figure 3: Trust Software Installer

Figure 3 will appear.




Figure 4: Trust Installer Software

5. Select the language you wish to use. (The language is only used in this program.) Figure 4 will appear.

Continue to chapter 4.2 to install the software for the mouse.

4.2 Installing the mouse software for Windows 95 / 98

1. Start the Trust Installer (see chapter 4.1).
2. Select the 'Install Ami Mouse Cordless Software' option (Figure 4). Figure 5 will appear.




Figure 6: Selecting the driver location

3. Click on ' Next'. Figure 6 will appear.

4. Click on 'Next'. A number of files will be copied to your hard drive. Figure 7 will then appear.

5. Choose to restart your computer and click on 'Finish'. The driver has now been successfully installed.

4.3 Installing the mouse software for Windows NT / 2000

1. Start the Trust Installer (see chapter 4.1).




Figure 8: Installation

2. Select the 'Install Ami Mouse Cordless Software' option (Figure 4). Figure 8 will appear.




Figure 9: Selecting the type of installation

3. Click on 'Next'. Figure 9 will appear.

4. Select 'Typical'.




Figure 10: Selecting the driver location

5. Click on 'Next' to continue. Figure 10 will appear.




Figure 11: Selecting the mouse

6. Click on 'Next'. A number of files will be copied to your hard drive. Figure 11 will appear when this is completed.

7. Select 'Trust Ami Mouse Cordless'.




Figure 12: Restarting the computer

8. Click on 'OK' to continue. Figure 12 will appear.

Note: *If the system requests confirmation, click 'Yes' to continue.*

9. Choose to restart your computer and click on 'Finish'. The driver has now been successfully installed.

5. Using the Ami Mouse Cordless

Note: *This Chapter only applies for Windows 95, 98, 2000 or NT4.
These functions do not work in other operating systems.*

The mouse buttons must be assigned functions using the installed software. This is carried out as follows:




Figure 14: Mouse properties

Double click on the Trust icon in your taskbar (Figure 13) to see the mouse properties. Figure 14 will appear.

Right-click on the icon to close the program.

5.1 Assigning the wheel functions




Figure 15: Programming the third mouse button

Click on the 'Wheel' tab. Figure 15 will appear. Use this tab to assign the 'Wheel' functions'.

Explanation of the functions:

- **Enhanced Dual Wheel function mode**
All the functions of the MS IntelliMouse plus vertical and horizontal scrolling in Windows 95, 98, 2000 and NT programs.
- **MS IntelliMouse Compatible mode**
Only the vertical scroll wheel works and has the same functions as the MS IntelliMouse.
- **Swap Vertical and Horizontal Wheel**
Swaps the functions of the vertical and horizontal scroll wheels.
- **Reverse vertical/horizontal scroll direction**
Reverses the scrolling direction.
- **Scrolling speed**
Sets the scrolling speed.
- **Scroll one page per scroll unit**
Scrolls a whole page when using the scroll wheel.

5.2 Configuration of the third mouse button

Click on the 'Third button' tab with the mouse. Figure 15 will appear. This tab is used to assign a certain function to the third mouse button.

- **Zoom**
If this function is selected, then the third mouse button can be used to magnify a document. The size before and after zooming can be set by clicking on the 'Settings' button.

Ami Mouse Cordless

- **Auto scroll**
Select this function to activate the scroll function using the third mouse button.
- **Control Key / Shift Key**
Select these functions to use the third mouse button as the 'Control' or 'Shift' key.
- **Others**
Select this function to use the third mouse button to start a certain function.

6. Maintenance

The moving parts of the mouse must be cleaned when the mouse no longer moves and/or reacts correctly.

1. Turn off the computer.
2. Lay the mouse upside down on the table.
3. Remove the protective plate in the direction shown by the arrows.
4. Remove the ball from the mouse and clean it with a clean, dry cloth.
5. Clean the rollers in the mouse with a clean cotton wool bud.
6. Replace the ball into the mouse and close the protective plate.

Note: *Do not use an aggressive cleaner, such as petrol or white spirit. This will harm the material.*

Note: *Never immerse the mouse in water or another liquid.*

7. Removing the driver

It is only necessary to remove the driver if you no longer wish to use the mouse. Follow the procedure given below:

1. Start the computer.
2. Close the mouse program in your taskbar.
 - a) Right-click on the icon (figure 13).
 - b) Select 'Exit' from the menu.
3. Click on the 'Start' button.
4. Click on 'Settings'.
5. Click on 'Control Panel'.
6. Click on the 'Add/Remove Programs' icon.
7. Select 'Trust Ami Mouse Cordless'.
8. Click on the 'Add/Remove...' button.
9. Next, click on 'Uninstall'.

The driver will be removed. Click on 'Yes' if your computer must be restarted.

8. Troubleshooting

Problem	Cause	Possible solution
The mouse pointer does not move.	The receiver is not connected correctly.	Reconnect the receiver (see chapter 2.1).
	The mouse is outside the range of the sender.	Use the mouse nearer to the sender.
	The receiver does not 'see' the mouse.	The front of the mouse must point to the front of the receiver.
	The batteries are empty.	Fit new batteries (see chapter 2.3).
	The batteries are fit incorrectly.	Fit the batteries with the correct polarity (see chapter 2.3).
Windows gives an error message when starting.	The receiver is not connected.	Connect the receiver correctly (see chapter 2.1).
The scrolling function does not work.	The software for your previous mouse is still active.	Remove the software for your previous mouse before installing this software. Consult the instruction manual for your previous mouse.
	The software is not installed.	Install the mouse software (see chapter 4).
	The mouse is in the wrong mode.	Set the mouse to the correct mode (see chapter 5.2).
	The mouse is not correctly installed in Windows 2000 or NT.	Remove the software and reinstall the mouse.
	The software is incorrectly installed.	Install the software correctly (see chapter 5.2).
	The application is not 100% compatible with Windows.	Use an application which is compatible.
The mouse pointer moves erratically.	The ball and rollers are dirty.	Clean the ball and rollers (see chapter 6).
