### Installation

- 2 Attach the table clamp to the steering wheel.
- 3 Attach the steering wheel securely to a table.  
Turn on the computer and connect the steering wheel to a free USB port on the computer. Windows will detect the steering wheel and install it automatically.
- 4  Windows 98SE: follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation. When requested, insert the Windows 98 SE CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive.

### Testing the steering wheel

- 5 Click 'Start – Control Panel'.  Windows 2000, Windows ME and Windows 98 SE: click 'Start – Settings – Control Panel'.
- 6 Double-click 'Game Controllers'.
- 7 Click 'Properties'.
- 8 Click the 'Test' tab and operate the steering wheel, pedals and buttons. If '+' and the buttons do not react correctly, remove the USB plug from the computer and then reconnect the steering wheel before trying again.

### Note

-  The steering wheel calibrates itself automatically and it is, therefore, not necessary to manually calibrate the steering wheel.
-  Testing the steering wheel:
-  In some games, the pedals must be configured before they can be used. See the instruction manual of the game concerned for more information.
-  The steering wheel uses the Windows driver and it is, therefore, not necessary to install an extra driver.
