- A:** Subwoofer
B: Satellite Speakers 5x

Standard cables

- F:** Mp3 player connecting cable
G: PC connecting cable
H: Subwoofer audio connecting cable
I: Subwoofer power cable

Control box

- C:** Volume setting separate channels
D: Main volume control
E: On/off button and LED

Video game console and DVD cables

- J:** Video game console connecting cable
K: DVD player connecting cables

Installation

- 1** - Connect mp3 player to the rear side of the control box by means of cable F
 - Connect PC by means of cable G
- 2** Connect speakers to the cables according to the labels and place the speakers as indicated.
 Use cable H for the Subwoofer
- 3** Connect the Subwoofer power cable (I) to the Subwoofer and to the control box as indicated.
- 4** Connect plug of subwoofer to the socket
 - Switch on power switch on rear side of Subwoofer.
- 5** - Start the control box. LED goes on.

The speaker set is now ready for use.

Optional: Connect video game console and DVD player

- 6** Connect X-Box or PlayStation by means of cables J and F according to picture.
- 7** Connect DVD player by means of cables K and G according to picture.

Configuration of 5.1 speakers in Windows XP

- 8** Click on Start and then on "run"
- 9** Type: **mmsys.cpl** and then click on **OK**
- 10** Click on "advanced"
- 11** Select 5.1 surround sound speakers and then click on **OK**

Tips



Installation

- Do not replace cables on the back panel while the unit is operating.
- The rear channel of some sound cards and DVD players are indicated as Surround. ("Sur")
- Put the subwoofer on the floor for optimum sound quality. Do not put the subwoofer next to a screen or the TV.



Surround sound

- The central speaker only operates during voice mode for DVDs with 5.1 sound and when the input of the Mp3 player is used.
- In case the sound of the Subwoofer and speaker is switched, use your sound card to counterbalance.
- None of the 6 speakers produce any sound during DVD display?
 - Turn all volume buttons for the channels on the control box to the right.
 - Configure 5.1 speakers in Windows. (step 8)
 - Configure 5.1 speakers in the software of the DVD player
 - Check if the cables are connected correctly to the sound card/DVD-player.
- Use the Equalizer in for instance Windows Media Player to set the sound features. (see links)



Safety instructions

- This device can produce sound of a high volume. Always increase the volume slowly.
- Never open or repair this device yourself.
- Do not use the device in a damp environment. Clean the device with a dry cloth.
- Make sure nothing is placed on the cable. Do not use this device where the cable can become worn or damaged as a result of people stepping on it.
- Under the following circumstances, remove the plug from the wall socket and have the device repaired by qualified personnel:
 - The cable or plug is damaged.
 - The device has been dropped or the casing is damaged.
 - The device does not work correctly.



Energy

- To save energy, turn the device off after use.
