**UK****Installation**

- 1 Turn on the PCs. Install the software on both PCs.
- 2 Insert the CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive. Click 'Install software'.
- 3
  - 1) Click 'Next'.
  - 2) Click 'Finish'.
- 4 Connect the USB plugs to both PCs.  
Windows 2000 → Device is ready for use.  
Windows XP + SP2 → 1) Select 'No, not this time'.  
2) Click 'Next'.
- 5 Select 'Install automatically (recommended)'. Click 'Finish'. The device is ready for use.

**Use**

  - A** – Double-click the Trust icon on the Windows desktop OR
  - B** – Use the Windows Start menu.

Two green balls in the bottom right-hand corner indicate that there is a connection between the PCs.
- 7 Drag and drop files and folders from PC 1 to PC 2. Files and folders can be managed in the same way as in Windows Explorer.

If a red ball is displayed in the window, this means that there is no connection with the other PC.
