

**Batteries**

- 1 Transmitter and receiver must be off. Place batteries.

**Use**

- 2 Switch receiver on firstly. Indicator flashes. One long beep, followed by continuous short beeps.
- 3 Switch transmitter on secondly. Indicator flashes. Receiver: One long beep, followed by one short beep. Set range, and place transmitter on your valuable.
- 4  Far: range 8 ~ 15 meter. Near: range 2 ~ 5 meter.
- 5 Keep receiver on yourself.
- 6 Alarm goes off when range is exceeded.

**Note** **Wireless performance**

- Transmission range is influenced strongly by putting away the devices. The range will decrease when keeping devices in clothing and luggage.
- Reduced wireless performance also caused by:
  - Metal objects close to or between the transmitter and receiver.
  - Concrete walls and floors.
  - Other wireless devices close by.
  - Empty batteries.

**Energy**

- This product consumes a relatively high amount of energy. Switch devices off if not in use.
- The receiver consumes more energy than the transmitter. Receiver battery must be replaced sooner.
- Replace batteries when sound weakens or range decreases. Only use CR2032 type.
- Never recharge the batteries provided and never throw them onto a fire.
- Observe local regulations when disposing of batteries.

**Safety instructions**

- Never use the device in a damp environment. Clean the device with a dry cloth.

**Wireless**

- This class 1 wireless device works at a frequency of 433 MHz. It meets the essential requirements and other relevant conditions of R&TTE Directive 1999/5/EC and can be used in the following countries: All European countries (except Poland), US, Canada and Taiwan.
- This device is **not allowed** in the following countries: Poland, Japan, China and Korea. There may be restrictions for the use of this device in other countries. Check whether this device meets the local regulations. Frequency: 433.82 ~ 435.8 MHz. Power: 0.01 ~ 0.25 mW.
- Be careful when using wireless devices if you have a pacemaker or are dependent on other life-saving, sensitive electronic equipment, because this device transmits radio signals.



- If possible, dispose of the device at a recycling centre. Do not dispose of the device with the household waste.
