Installation


- Insert batteries

- 1 - Connect power adapter to cradle
- Charge batteries

2 PC off

- 3 **A:** Connect USB or
B: use USB to PS/2 converter

- 4  Windows 98SE follow onscreen instructions to finish!


- 5 Press connection button Cradle; Status LED flashing

- 6 Press connection button Mouse → Mouse is connected

Install Driver

- 7 Place CD in CD-ROM

Click "Install Driver"; Follow on screen instructions to finish

- 8  Restart system when prompt!

- 9 Click "Continue anyway" 2x (Only in Windows XP Service Pack 2 and Higher)


- 10 Click "Finish"

After reboot, mouse is ready to Use

Use Tilt and Office button

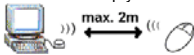
- 11 Activate horizontal(tilt) scroll by moving the scroll wheel sideways . Move up and down for normal scroll function.
- 12 Click office helper button to launch a desired office application and click again to use popular commands in the opened application.

Reminders

 Less performance

- Metal object close to or in between the device and PC → Remove object.

- Shiny or transparent surface material which may cause sensor imprecision → Use a mousepad.
- Interference with other devices. → Move channel switch inside battery compartment to second channel and repeat step 5 and 6.
- Batteries empty. → Recharge.



General usage

- Adjust the speed of mouse pointer: (1) Open Windows Help (Start → Help). (2) Search “adjust the speed of mouse pointer”. (3) Follow instructions
- Read the manual on CD for the use of the configuration program
- Install Trust Easy Mouse Configuration software on CD to configure the 3rd, 4th and 5th button and use tilt scroll.

Power

- Keep mouse on cradle no longer than 48 hours.
- Do not attempt to recharge alkaline batteries. There is a danger of them exploding.
- Device will go into sleep mode after 10 minutes. Wake up by clicking any button.
